

Daniel 10 – The Cosmic Battle

If we read the book of Daniel from start to finish, we can see that from the time he was taken captive he had many interesting and varied experiences. Although originally taken captive by the Babylonians he was able to live and work as a high ranking official through two kingdoms and remain totally faithful to God. In every chapter Daniel shows his loyalty to God through his prayers, fasting and studies of the scripture. We can also see from this chapter of Daniel how he was rewarded with interactions with angels such as Gabriel and Jesus Himself.

After three weeks of prayer and fasting, whilst walking by the river Daniel was given a vision. In this vision he saw someone who resembled, and was, Jesus. Daniel was so amazed by this vision that he became weak and felt inadequate and he fell to the ground. His companions could not see the vision but knew something strange was happening, so they ran away and hid themselves.

Whilst on the ground face down, the angel Gabriel touched Daniel and eventually told him to stand. The reason for Gabriel's visit was to tell Daniel that he was greatly loved and that he had something important to tell him.

Gabriel told Daniel from the time he started to pray and fast for understanding, God heard his prayers. A command was given for Gabriel to personally go to give an explanation, but he had been met with opposition. Gabriel in fact had been battling against Satan for three weeks. Curious how this could be true, she smilingly inquired from the owner, what would be the catch in buying this bedding? The owner simply replied "flaws" all these are placed in this box to be cleared hence the price.

The lady went through the entire chest bagging up her bargains and was not convinced that the shop owner had done a good job in his reply. Mr Manyenje!, she called, but what does the flaws do? Well, young lady, these linens have some faulty stitching or markings and patterns most of them are hardly noticeable, he explained.

This just reminds me of some faithful bible characters who have a good record in their walk with God. Although strong in faith, these too got it wrong at some point showing their weaker part in life. Let's meet a few.

ELIJAH

He is known to be a man of prayer, faithful prayer. He prayed that it should not rain and it happened. He prayed sincerely. There was no rain for the period of three years and six months, James 5:17. By this time the ground was very thirsty and people were concerned for their lives as the famine was so severe. 1 kings 18:1-2. The ground needed rain to heal so that it produced food for both man and beast, 1 kings 18:5. It takes faith and total surrender, believing that God listens to our prayers.

Elijah said call on the name of your gods (for they were pagans, idol worshippers), and I will call on the name of the LORD: and the God

that answereth by fire, let him be God. And all the people answered and said, It is well spoken.

A lot of prayers and drama took place at Mount Carmel. It was a real drama indeed. Baal's prophets cut themselves to gain attention from their gods, so their request for fire would be honoured, but to no avail. 1 Kings 18:26-29.

To their mockery, it only took a prayer to the true God in heaven, for the fire to fall on Elijah's altar. It is clear that no funny, hysterical chanting was performed to please God to send the fire, 1 kings 18:42-44. The true God was accepted by the people, the false prophets slain and Elijah then prayed for rain.

Each time he prayed, he sent his servant to go and check for a cloud, a sign of rain, this is really faith! Elijah prayed seven times and it rained cats and dogs! 1 kings 18:45.

Upon receiving the message that all the false prophets had been slain, 1 kings19:1-2, Mrs Ahab, Jezebel, was vexed and sought revenge. She wanted Elijah dead! It only took Jezebel for Elijah, a man known of solid faith, to run into hiding for his life. Where was his faith? 1 kings19:3-4.

ABRAHAM

So obedient a man he was, of a strong faith in God, of a good record in his walk with the Creator. Genesis12:1-2, 4. It only took his wife for him to fall, Genesis16:2-3. He distrusted God's promise of giving him a son, the only promised child of his life by his wife Sarah. The man accepted to have a child by his maid servant Hagar. He agreed with Sarah's plan to break God's original plan of the couple bearing a son despite their old age.

Could it be that he was pushed to the limit or was he brain washed? Genesis15:2-4. Our heavenly Father is full of compassion. He fulfilled the promise he made to this couple, they had Isaac and by him, Abraham became father of nations.





Biblical Conundrums?

In Genesis chapter 6 we read: **1** And it came to pass, when men began to multiply on the face of the earth, and daughters were born unto them, **2** That the sons of God saw the daughters of men that they were fair; and they took them wives of all which they chose. **3** And the LORD said, My spirit shall not always strive with man, for that he also is flesh: yet his days shall be an hundred and twenty years. **4** There were giants in the earth in those days; and also after that, when the sons of God came in unto the daughters of men, and they bear children to them, the same became mighty men which were of old, men of renown. Genesis 6:1-4.

This text has been interpreted in different ways by many of those who translated the text from the original Hebrew into the English language. Some say that the sons of God were angels who saw that the daughters of men were fair, had relations with them resulting in the birth of children who grew up to become mighty men. Others are of the opinion that the sons of God are those who are worshippers of God and that the daughters of men are the daughters of those who no longer worshipped God. If we go back to Genesis 6:4 and ignore the parts written in italics we read "There were giants in the earth in those days; and also after that, when the sons of God came in unto the daughters of men, and they bear children to them, the same became mighty men which were of old, men of renown". It is plain that the offspring of the sons of God and the daughters of men were the same...mighty men... not an amalgamation of angels and men, if this were the case they could not have been referred to as men.

In her comment on this text E.G. White stated that the descendants of Seth were the righteous line and they were the sons of God and that the descendants of Cain were the sons of men, since they apostatised from the worship of God. The disciple John's statement put this debate beyond all shadow of doubt, he wrote: Beloved, now are we the sons of God, and it doth not yet appear what we shall be: but we know that, when He shall appear, we shall be like Him; for we shall see Him as He is.1 John 3:2
